2011 Award Nomination Criteria

To be considered as a Woman of Achievement, the nominee must demonstrate the following characteristics:

- The YWCA vision of the *elimination of racism and the empowerment of women*.
- Giving back to the community through her time, talent and/or resources.
- Helping women and girls achieve their goals.
- Leadership in her profession and/or community.

Nomination materials must respond to the following questions about the nominee:

1. How has the nominee demonstrated a commitment to the *elimination of racism and the empowerment of women*?
2. How has the nominee given back to the community?
3. How has the nominee helped other women and girls achieve their goals?
4. How has the nominee ever been involved with a YWCA?
5. How has the nominee shown professional and/or community leadership?
6. In 100 words or less, describe why your nominee is a Woman of Achievement.

 2. A brief resume or biography highlighting the nominee's achievements and community involvement. Resumes and biographies should be no longer than two pages (single-sided).
 3. At least two letters of recommendation in support of the nominee. Letters should be no longer than one page in length (single- sided).
